
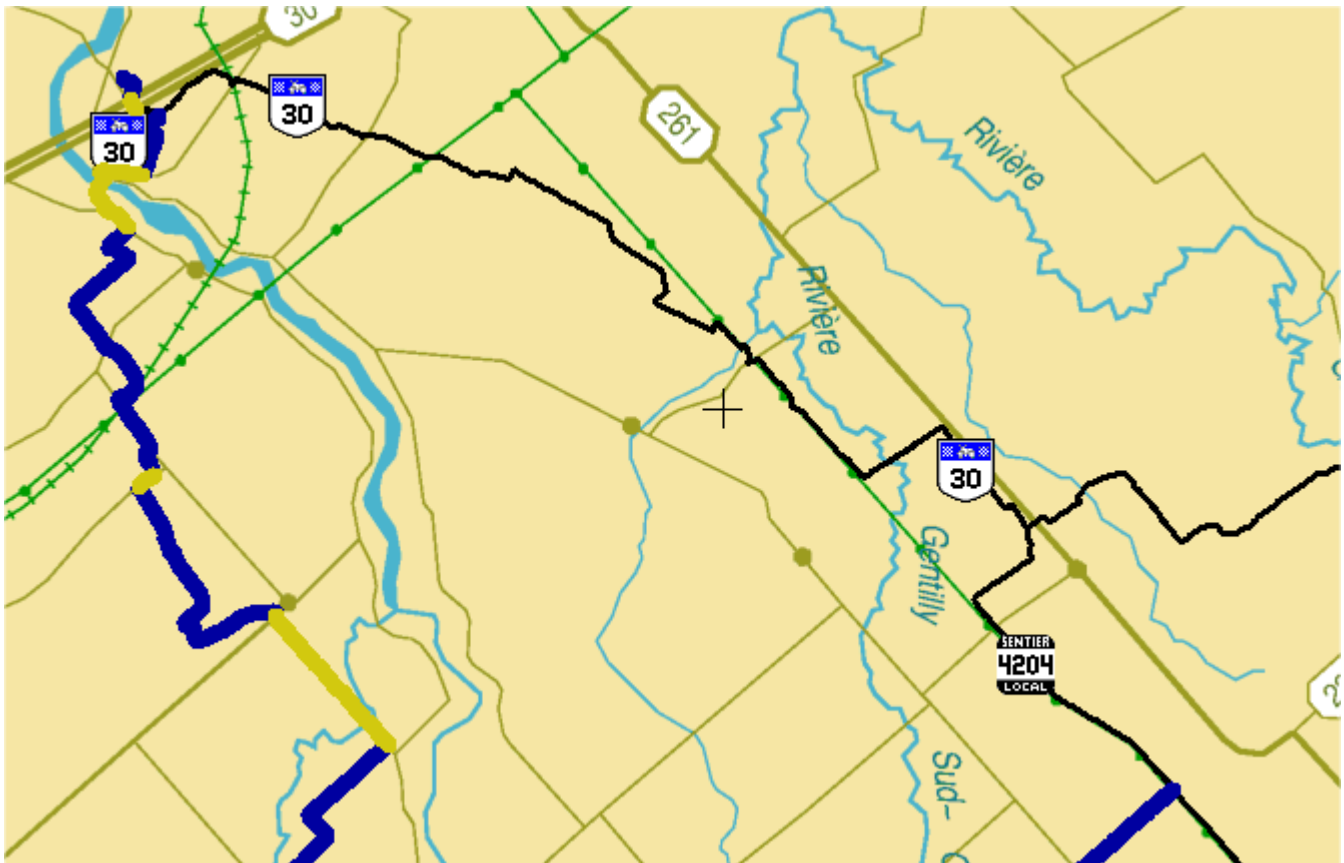


How to transfer ATV trails to GPS procedure

To transfer ATV trails in your GPS, you must take the trails, which are in a SoftMap database, and copy them in a GPS database. Here is the way to proceed.


1. Click on the rectangular selection tool .
2. Make a rectangle that includes the trails you want to send to the GPS. More often than not, the trails contain a lot of points and we suggest not to select a large quantity of trails at the same time. Otherwise, the transfer time will be long and the quantity of information may be too important for your GPS receiver. Consult your GPS user guide to know its limits.



NOTE: It is essential to select at least two trails to have access to the transfer.


3. Click on the *Information* button .

4. In the *Information* box, click on the *Line* tab.


5. Select all segments in the dialog box.

6. Then, you have to choose in which form you want your trails. Click on this button  to export the selected trails as routes. If you want to export the trails in tracks, rather than routes, click on this button .

7. By clicking the button, the *Import the selected lines* box will open.



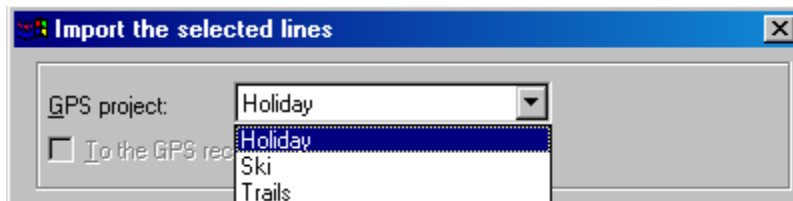



8. Choose the GPS database in which you want to put your trails.



9. Once the GPS database is selected, click on the *Transfer* button .

10. Close the *Information box*.

11. Go to the GPS menu to upload your trails in your GPS receiver.
